- Make sure you have been involved with a school or community club; extracurricular activity; social enterprise or subject challenge.
- Are there any roles of responsibility for which you could volunteer (office monitor; open evening ambassador, form representative).
- Remember the more you do now the more you will have to record on your CV later to make you stand out from the crowd!
- Keep certificates safe for your record of achievement folder later on.
